At the northern end of the Singapore River is trendy neighborhood Robertson Quay. You'll recognize it by its colorful, painted bridge which has become a local landmark. In the area are fashionable restaurants, bars and cafes ranging from popular Japanese eateries to gourmet food shops. The newer establishments are clustered at The Pier, a recent residential and retail development. Check out La Maison Du Whisky Singapore, (#01-10 The Pier at Robertson Quay, 80 Mohamed Sultan Rd., 6733-0059) that offers specialty premium whiskeys, Rotabayaki Yoyogi (#01-04 The Pier, 80 Mohamed Sultan Rd., 6733-8711) a Japanese grill restaurant, or Brasserie Wolf (#01-13 The Pier at Robertson, 80 Mohamed Sultan Rd., 6835-7818), a traditional French style brasserie. Nearby is also the Singapore Tyler Print Institute (41 Robertson Quay, 6336-3663), where fine contemporary paper works are on display. From Oct 6-28 the exhibition Feng Mengbo is on. This leading Chinese artist will showcase new media art, including two video-installations and thirty works on canvas. His works draw inspiration from videogames, so expect something different.

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
