Scholar Julia Bryan-Wilson considers how women of color artists like Pacita Abad and Rosie Lee Tompkins have used embellishment as a strategy to blur the lines between function and décor. Her talk examines how these artists' practice of intricately adorning domestic objects can expand our understanding of women's work. Bryan-Wilson's 2017 book Fray: Art and  $\it Textile Politics$  won prestigious awards such as the ASAP Book Prize, the Frank Jewett Mather Award, and the Robert Motherwell Book Award. Her show "Louise Nevelson: Persistence" is an official collateral event of the 2022 Venice Biennale, and her monograph on Nevelson is forthcoming in 2023.
