Three Innovative Exhibitions by Women at MoMA PS1

MoMA PS1 recently opened three landmark exhibitions of women artists. Monumental and meticulously detailed, unapologetically feminist and visually stunning, these must-see shows will stop you in your tracks.

Pacita Abad's first major retrospective celebrates an under-recognized artist with a presentation of over 50 textiles, costumes, ceramics, and works on paper, most of which have never before been seen in the US.

Melissa Cody, a fourth-generation Navajo/Diné weaver, builds on traditional techniques with new technology to create masterful works in experimental palettes and patterns.

Regina José Galindo's monumental video installation explores connections between the exploitation of labor, resources, and human life in Guatemala—marking the first in a series of presentations premiering works from MoMA's collection at PS1. 22-25 Jackson Avenue Long Island City, NY 11101
